Kevin Crown
"Through the Lense of Time:
Images of the Civil War, Then and Now"

Kevin Crown is a professional land planner with over 40 years of experience in the planning and design of all types of real estate development projects. He has worked for land planning and engineering consulting firms providing expertise in the design and entitlement of land projects, as well as served as the manager of land projects for major land development companies.

Although a native of Maryland, Kevin has several connections to South Carolina. He holds a B.A. from Furman University, as well as a Master's degree from Clemson University. His first job as a professional planner took him to Aiken where he worked for the Lower Savannah Council of Governments. He currently works for Bowman Consulting Group in their Leesburg, Virginia office, but has provided planning assistance to Bowman's Daniel Island office, designing several real estate development projects in the Charleston area and throughout the southeast. Charleston has been like a "second home" to Kevin and his wife, Packie, as they have several life-long friends who reside in the Charleston area and visit Charleston several times during the year.

One of Kevin's many interests is history, particularly history related to the Civil War. Having grown up in an area that provided easy access to some of the war's major battlefields, such as Gettysburg, Antietam, and Fredericksburg, Kevin was introduced to these major historical sites at an early age and developed a keen interest in the military strategies and personalities that fought during this conflict. He considers himself an "amateur historian" and possesses an extensive personal library of both modern and antique books on the Civil War. In recent years, Kevin has undertaken researching the vast collection of original Civil War photographs maintained by the Library of Congress and attempted to replicate the modern photographic view of various buildings and structures that remain today and are depicted in these original photographs. The result is an interesting "then and now" comparison of images of prominent sites in the Civil War including the Charleston area.

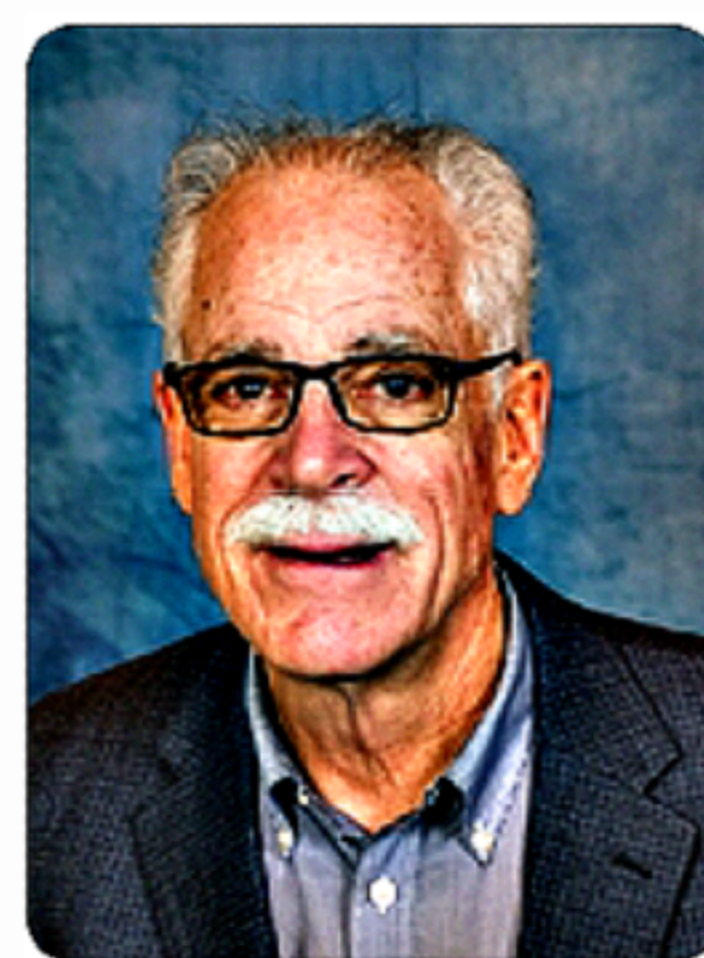
