

Layla's path toward advocacy began when her son was diagnosed with autism. She decided to take a stand, becoming a powerful voice for the Autistic and Neurodiverse communities by founding Just Bee. Her journey is a testament to her relentless pursuit of creating a more inclusive and understanding world.

In 2021, Layla relocated to the Lowcountry, bringing her unwavering commitment with her. In 2023, she achieved a remarkable feat by making Mount Pleasant, the first Autism-Friendly town in the Lowcountry. Her efforts were instrumental in Mount Pleasant winning the prestigious All-American City Award. Layla's tireless advocacy also earned her the Jefferson Award and the Multiplying Good Award. Through education, awareness campaigns, and advocacy, Layla tirelessly worked to bridge the gap between families and their local communities. She facilitated partnerships, raised awareness, and provided training resources to local governments and businesses, making them sensory-friendly and encouraging positive experiences and opportunities for individuals with autism.

Layla's grassroots movement is rooted in being the voice for her son, Rio, and the millions of other individuals like him. 
